

RESOLUTION NO. 18-03

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET AND REVISING
APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 17-18**

WHEREAS, ORS 294.471 allows that a governing body of a municipal corporation to make a supplemental budget for an occurrence or condition that is not ascertained when preparing the original budget for the current year; and


WHEREAS, the adoption of Ordinance 242-17, known as the Solid Waste Management Ordinance, ordered that City of Irrigon shall do all billing, coordination and collection of the service fees on a monthly basis causing an increase of resources coming in. City shall wholesale collection and solid waste services on a monthly basis, causing an increase in expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Irrigon has met publication requirements outlined by ORS 294.471 for those supplemental budgets that include amending any funds that differ by less than 10 percent in the regular budget for that fiscal year.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRRIGON THAT THE COUNCIL ADOPTS A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET TO INCREASE RESOURCES IN THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,600 FOR THE BILLING OF COLLECTION SERVICE FEES FOR A TOTAL OF \$609,300 IN RESOURCES AND INCREASE THE GENERAL FUND MATERIAL AND SERVICES APPROPRIATIONS BY \$40,600 FOR THE WHOLESALE COLLECTION AND SOLID WASTE SERVICES TO \$227,500 FOR A NEW TOTAL REQUIREMENT OF \$609,300.
