EXCESSIVE FORCE POLICY

WHEREAS, The City of Irrigon is charged with providing Public Services for the health and safety, such as maintenance to public infrastructures; and

WHEREAS, The City of Irrigon has been awarded a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) provided from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through Infrastructure Finance Authority (IFA)- Business Oregon; and

WHEREAS, Establishment of such policy is required to meet any such requirement(s) which are based upon the successful CDBG grant award, and


WHEREAS, It is the policy of The City of Irrigon to support and commit to ensuring all members have the liberties and freedoms to engage civil right actions within the limits to express their respective points of views afforded by the constitution, laws and ordinances,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Irrigon it is the policy of the City of Irrigon that;


- (1) law enforcement personnel shall not use excessive force against any individual(s) engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations, and
- (2) all applicable federal, state and local laws that prohibit physically barring entrances to or exists from a facility or location which is subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction shall be enforced.
