

RESOLUTION NO. 23-01

**A RESOLUTION SETTING VARIATION FROM HISTORIAL POLICY OF
INFRASTRUCTURE ADJUSTMENT WHEN TIME AND BUDGET CAN BE
ADJUSTED IN THE CITY OF IRRIGON, OR**

WHEREAS, The City of Irrigon is charged with providing Public Services for the health and safety, such as maintenance to public infrastructures; and

WHEREAS, The Irrigon City Council desires to see continued growth and development while safely and fiscally meeting the infrastructure needs of Irrigon's constituents; and

WHEREAS, The City of Irrigon has opportunity to perform variation opportunities on infrastructure that provides street maintenance, sewer, and water installation or upgrading that is fiscal and timely; and


WHEREAS, A variation from prior infrastructure improvements do not set precedence but provides direction for staff and understanding for the public;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:


1. Any and all projects must be grant funded and/or fiscally budgeted. Funds may come from sources such as legislative earmarks, CREZ dollars, County fiscal support, designated tax resources, etc.
2. Typically, water and sewer infrastructure will be installed prior to any roadway work or surfacing. Paving should take place only if fiscal resources are available and underground infrastructure (water and sewer) is not scheduled or available to commence within fifteen (15) years. It is then safe to make determination to pave such streets to meet public safety and infrastructure improvement.
